Hi all, on doing some browsing here and elsewhere it seems more and more are converting to Mac. I've been using one for a long time now and to welcome those to the far superior platform I thought I'd let those new converts in on how to run decoplanner natively within OSX. Hope it helps.

Step 1: Go to this address and download Wineskin Winery (free).

Step 2: Open your newly downloaded Winery program

click the + button next to the "new engines available" text and choose WS7Wine1.3.23

It should now look like this:

Step 3: Click create new blank wrapper

You should now see this screen:

rename to Decoplanner and click OK.

When its asks if you want to install Gecko DON'T, its just a browser and I'm sure you already use the one you want to.

Step 4: When complete click "open in finder" and you should now been taken to a folder with a decoplanner icon, open this file to see the following:

Step 5: Click "install windows software" and locate your decoplanner .exe file

Decoplanner will now install (as if it was on windows) when complete go back to your Decoplanner icon in the wineskin folder, right click and select show package contents, open the winery application in this folder. Select Advanced for the following screen:

In the bottom right corner you can change the icon to something more relevant as shown..

Step 6: The decoplanner icon in the wineskin folder should now be the one you have chosen, drag it to the bar at the bottom of the screen and enjoy.

Hi

I've just installed the latest version of Wineskin 2.5 and its WS 1.3.23 to use Decoplanner on my Mac (Mavericks)

On the latest version of Wineskin, the previous WS7 1.3.23 (referred to in this great tutorial) is no longer available and any attempt to install it results in Wineskin upgrading to the WS8 version - WS8 1.3.23

Decoplanner seems to work fine except the help files are unavailable - even though the PDF decoplanner manual is contained in the programme. Guess it must either be a Wineskin bug or perhaps it didn't work with the previous WS7 version of the engine
