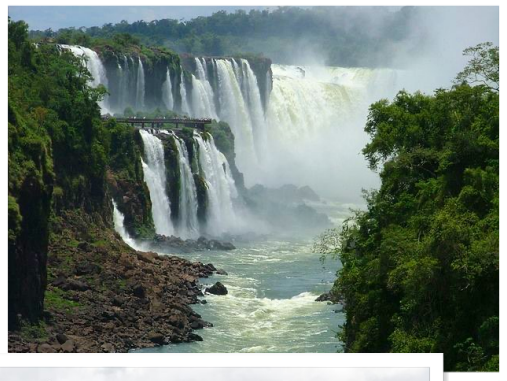


Patagonia

January 13-19th, 2022

Our Patagonian adventure begins in El Calafate, a town near the edge of the Southern Patagonian Ice Field in the Argentine province of Santa Cruz. It's mainly known as the gateway to Los Glaciares National Park, home to the massive Perito Moreno Glacier, whose ever-shifting icy landscape is popular for hiking and sightseeing. **While there are a range of activities appropriate for a wide range of physical abilities, many treks do require average to above average physical conditioning. All activities are subject to change depending on the weather which can be very dynamic.** We will spend a full day exploring the National Park, including getting up close to the Perito Moreno Glacier via a short boat trip to the immense south wall of the glacier. Our next stop takes us to El Chaltén, a small mountain village in Santa Cruz Province, Argentina, 220 km north of El Calafate. It is located on the riverside of Rio de las Vueltas, within the Los Glaciares National Park at the base of Cerro Torre and Cerro Fitz Roy mountains. El Chaltén is a popular base for hiking numerous trails, such as Laguna Torre and Laguna de los Tres (near the base of Fitz Roy). We have the option to do one of several treks to Lago de los Tres, Laguna Torre, Pleigue Tumbado, Laguna Capri, or Cerro Torre. After a couple days amongst the beautiful peaks in Patagonia, we will continue on to Iguazu, Argentina, where we will visit the majestic Iguazu Falls, which make up part of the largest waterfall system in the world. For most of its course, the Iguazu river flows through Brazil; however, since most of the falls are on the Argentine side, this is the side we will visit. Below its confluence with the San Antonio River, the Iguazu River forms the boundary between Argentina and Brazil. Join us on this amazing hiking and trekking adventure following the 2022 Blue Green Expeditions Antarctica expedition.
