28.06.2025 : Pasubio wreck (35-42m)

During the dives we were able to:

Collect video documentation of all visited places;

Make a 3D model of the bow part of the Capitan Antonio wreck;

Make a 3D model of the stern part of the Capitan Antonio wreck;

Make a 3D model of the cannon and parts of the aft deck on the wreck of Cosala;

Remove ghost nets from the anchor and stern of the wreck of Pasubio;
